

## Changes in 4.0.5

- Fixed a bug that intermittently caused EPS files to be printed with fonts substituted to Courier.

## Changes in 4.0.4

- Moved the preferences file and the default document file to the Preferences folder.
- Fixes incompatibilities (error messages, printing errors) caused by the use of the current system font in a document under MacOS 8.0 and later.
- Fixed tracking of the graphic ?s file name in the object note when a missing graphic file is replaced with another file.
- Fixed an incompatibility opening and saving files on Novell servers accessed through Mac IPX.
- Made the font menu always show a checkmark next to the font used by the first character in the text selection.
- Fixed the on-screen display of some EPS files.
- Fixed the character spacing of certain algorithmic styles of certain TrueType fonts at certain sizes under MacOS 8.5 and 8.5.1.
- Fixed the display of style settings in the status area, the Find/Change dialog, and the Character dialog.
- Fixed a bug that allowed the Smooth and Unsmooth commands to operate on locked polygons if an unlocked polygon was also selected.
- Made saved Creator files and CIF files always contain a thumbnail-sized PICT resource for improved integration with Multi-Ad Cumulus. The "Save ad previews" preference setting now controls only whether a full-size preview PICT resource is included.
- Made invisible folders invisible in Place dialog.
- Fixed minor problems with the starburst tool and the polygon tool.
- Fixed display bug with gradients introduced in recent system software changes.
- Fixed display bug with polygons introduced in recent system software changes.

## Changes made to our exported EPS files

- Made them correctly report the number of bytes in compressed image data.
- Made them correctly report process plate usage.
- Fixed problem color separating gradients in EPS files created by Creator in PageMaker 6.5.

## Printing changes

- Fixed color separation of grayscale Photoshop EPS files with a transfer function.
- Made Creator properly recognize comments in EPS files documenting enclosed fonts, and not issue a missing fonts warning at print time when enclosed fonts are not in the system.
- Added a PREPS OPI option to our panel in the Print dialog that makes our PostScript output work properly with PREPS imposition software.
